FORGOTTEN TALES closest to the pace three wide, tired in the drive. JIMMY THE KID prominent early between rivals, was in close quarters near the half mile marker then could not threaten late. MANDOORULE bumped RAPHAEL ALEXANDRO at the start, was forwardly placed for a half while off the inside and tired. RAPHAEL ALEXANDRO bumped by MANDOORULE after hopping in the air at the start, was outrun for a half and could not menace. REGIONS REWARD close up between rivals, was in close quarters near the half mile marker and faded. CARSON'S PRIDE steadied at the start when in tight, was reserved off the inside and could not menace. MILITARY SECRET steadied at the start and was outrun. MIRACLE ICE broke in the air and was always far back.
