TOP SMOOCHER close up four wide, moved in a bit on the backstretch, moved up three wide on the second turn, challenged once in the stretch and drew clear under steady urging. SWEDEN closest to the pace three wide, challenged from the two path on the second turn, battled into midstretch and held on for the place. MY GIRLS ROCK lost her action momentarily when squeezed after the start, was outrun for a half, advanced four wide on the second turn and made a good late gain. MIZLOU within striking distance off the inside, lacked a late bid. SHARKETTE set the pace, saved ground on the second turn and tired in the final furlong. SMALLISGOOD outrun early, raced in the four path on the second turn and was no real threat. ELLA POOH steadied entering the first turn when angling to the inside, brushed the rail early on the backstretch when inside MY GIRLS ROCK then was no threat. INDIAN NATIVE close up along the inside, tired. BATES CAT drifted in early tightening up MY GIRLS ROCK then never menaced. JULIE NEKIA close up along the inside, faded.

YALLAH LEAH outrun three wide, swung out five wide leaving the turn and made a late gain. YOUTHQUAKE outrun four wide, moved six wide late on the turn and closed well on the outside. GOLDEN PROFILE reserved three wide, moved out a path late on the turn and improved her position late. SOLD TWO vied for the early lead along the inside and tired. PROS N CONS within striking distance along the inside, angled out for the drive and tired. DARE forwardly placed off the inside, faded. A RARE MOVE could not menace.

MINIMAST closest to the pace three wide, challenged when ready approaching the stretch, gained a short lead after a mile and one quarter, responded willingly when joined by the winner in midstretch and held on gamely to be second best while not quite good enough. SARKOZY reserved for one mile, made a good four wide move thereafter, reached a challenging position with a quarter mile to go but tired in the drive. EXTERIOR unhurried for a mile, swung out seven wide entering the stretch and improved his position while no threat. SPOKALU set the pace off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. COPPER BOTTOM forwardly placed, saved ground on the second turn and gave way. LACE MANZOTTI close up three wide, moved out six wide entering the stretch and faded. A. P. JEWEL was no factor. ROYAL REPRIEVE four wide early when within striking distance, stopped.
